In the Government order read above, the Government have issued orders specifying the officers of the Transport Department not below the rank of a Motor Vehicle Inspector, Grade-II to compound an offence punishable under subsection (2) of section 190 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988) for violation of pollution control standards, for the amount mentioned

(a). First offence Warning
(b) Second offence Second offence Rs. 100/-(Rupees one hundred only) Third offence : Rs.200/-(Rupees two hundred only) Fourth offence Rs.500/-(Rupees five hundred only) (e) Fifth and Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One thousand

It was also ordered that the offence be recorded in the Registration Certificate of the Vehicle.

- 2. The Transport Commissioner has reported that there was difficulty in enforcing the above order as most of the vehicle owners carry only the Xerox copy of the Registration Certificate. The original Registration Certificate lies either with the agency or bank/institution, which advanced the loan for purchase of the said vehicle. Even in other cases, the vehicle owners preferred to take the copy only for safety purposes. Therefore, recording in the original Registration Certificate was not possible in most of the cases. Consequently, there was difficulty in ascertaining the fact whether the offence was a first time one. In fact, everyone claims that it is for the first time. To overcome the above difficulties, the Transport Commissioner has suggested to impose uniform rate of fine of Rs.500/-(Rupees five hundred only) for four wheelers of Transport / Non -Transport Vehicles and a fine of Rs.250/- (Rupees two hundred and fifty only) for two wheelers and three wheelers of Transport / Non - Transport Vehicles and to delegate powers to the officers of the Transport Department not below the rank of Motor Vehicle Inspector Grade- II and the officers of the Police Department not below the rank of Sub - Inspector of Police in uniform to impose the fine. The Chairman, Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board has also endorsed the suggestion of the Transport Commissioner.
- Transport Commissioner, have decided to specify an amount of Rs. 500/(Rupees five hundred only) for four wheelers of Transport / Non Transport
 Vehicles and of Rs.250/- (Rupees two hundred and fifty only) for two and three
 wheelers of Transport / Non Transport Vehicles for compounding the offence
 of violation of road safety and Pollution norms punishable under sub section
 (2) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988) and to specify the
 officers of the Transport Department not below the rank of Motor Vehicle
 Inspector, Grade II and the officers of the Police Department not below the rank
 of Sub Inspector of Police in uniform to compound such offence.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 200 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988) and in supersession of the Home Department Notification. No.II/HO/1335/97 dated the 29th May 1997 published at page 407 of Part II Section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the 18th June 1997, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby specifies the officers of the Transport Department not below the rank of Motor Vehicle Inspector, Grade - II and the officers of the Police Department not below the rank of Sub - Inspector of Police in uniform to compound an offence

punishable under sub - section (2) of section 190 of the said Act in respect of the motor vehicles and for the amount, specified below:-

1) Four Wheelers Rs. 500/-
